Luis Roberto Martínez Montenegro	1978	Reporter of Noroeste specializing in topics linked to drug trafficking, he publicly pointed to the then Attorney General's Office delegate in Sinaloa as the one responsible, but apparently it was a theory that was never investigated	Unpunished
José Guadalupe Mendívil	August 1979		Unpunished
Aarón Casimiro Flores Heredia	1980	Public suspicion at the time was directed at the then governor, Alfonso G. Calderón, and police chief Guillermo Casillas Romero. It was never investigated	Unpunished
Jesús Michel Jacobo	December 17, 1987	Murdered in downtown Culiacán, he was also a human rights defense lawyer. His death was linked to denunciations of corruption and organized crime that he published	Unpunished
Gregorio Rodríguez Hernández	November 28, 2004	He was murdered as he was having dinner with his children. The authorities says in the case file that the mastermind was a local drug traffickers who had been photographed with a now jailed police chief	The mastermind has yet to be arrested
Oscar Rivera Inzunza	September 5, 2007	For several years a reporter for El Noroeste, he became spokesman for the state Attorney General's Office. He is believed to have been killed because of his work and the murder is linked to the illicit drug trade.	Unpunished
